[&]quot;NON – COMPETITIVE" – a club member that is completely familiar with the rules and who may even have played competitively, but prefers a bit slower and less aggressive game.

[&]quot;OPEN" – all club members playing at any level. All four players on the court need to play at everyone's comfort level. More experienced players might use this game to practice some different strategies or placing the ball rather than smashing the ball, etc. The inexperienced players would use the same game to improve their skills also, but still feeling comfortable on the court.

[&]quot;COMPETITIVE" – a club member that is very proficient in the rules and strategies of the game. Has played competitively in tournaments or would be working toward that level, or is at that level but has not actually played in a tournament. This player is comfortable with very aggressive play.

[&]quot;NEW PLAYERS" – a club member that has not yet had the experience of playing one full season, multiple times per week on a consistent basis and is not completely familiar with all the rules of play.
